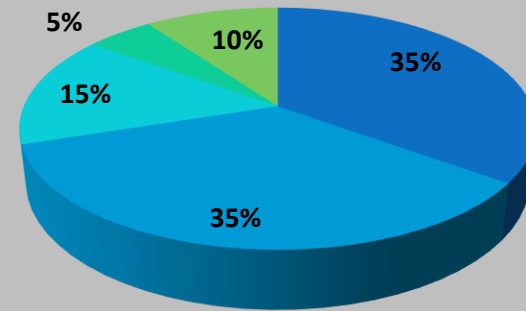

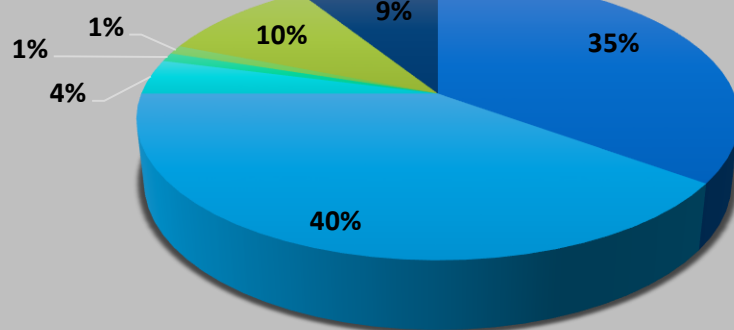

# Farmpreneur: *Health and Nutrition*

Baseline Anthropometric survey conducted with more than 2200 students from 65 schools. Apart from poor BMI, many specially girls suffers from *acute anaemia* as per the blood haemoglobin tests results

Nutrition survey and training kit distributed to 20 schools in Jorhat in partnership with Ashoka India and Swiss Re

Apart from *Life skills* students are also imparted *Health promoting behaviour training*.

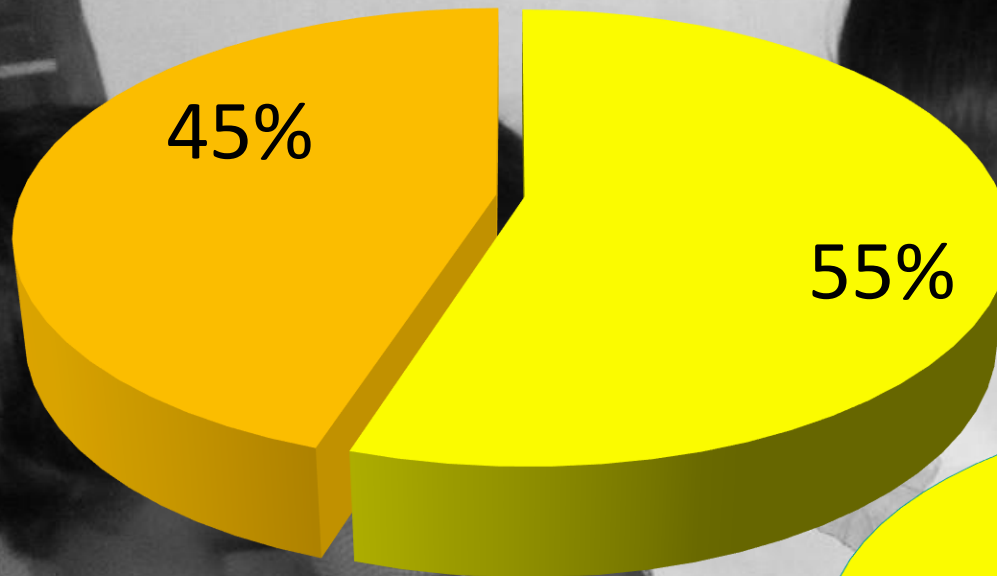
In the past 1 year, more than 610Kgs of local nutritious vegetables and herbs produced and consumed through Mid Day Meals.



# Farm2Food: *Gender Mapping*

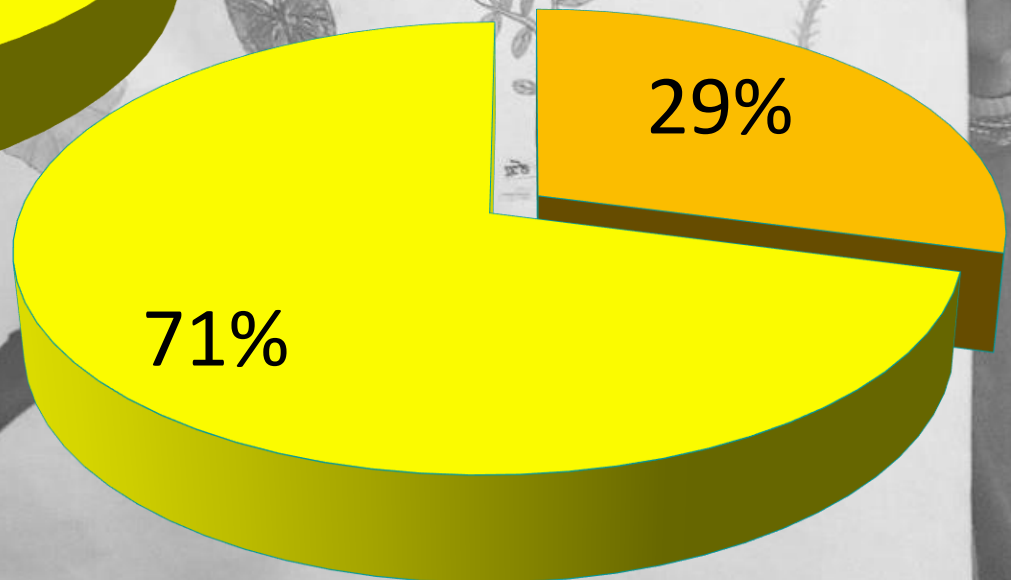

**Total production for the year 2017-18 is approx 610 Kgs**

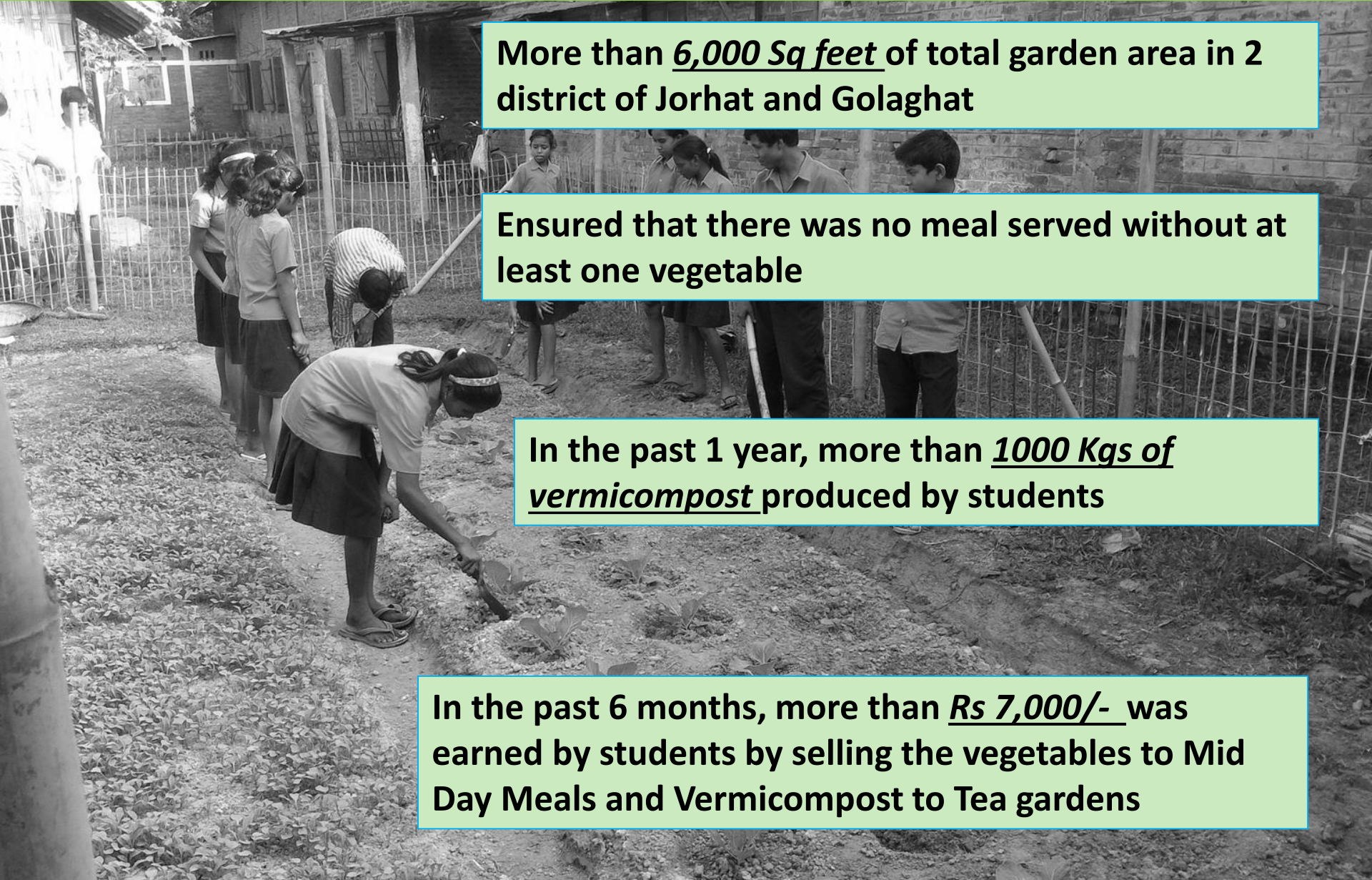
# Farmpreneur: *Micro entreprise*

More than 6,000 Sq feet of total garden area in 2 district of Jorhat and Golaghat

Ensured that there was no meal served without at least one vegetable

In the past 1 year, more than 1000 Kgs of vermicompost produced by students

In the past 6 months, more than Rs 7,000/- was earned by students by selling the vegetables to Mid Day Meals and Vermicompost to Tea gardens





# Farmpreneur: *Community engagement*

Co creating a supportive ecosystem on Health and Education

Beej daan yatra conducted by students collecting local seeds of vegetables and herbs. Students covered more than 25 villages.

Mothers group and community members are integral part of the program. Through Shram, Beej and Gyan daan parents have enriched the program.

# Farmpreneur: *Experiential education*..


School Nutrition Garden is positioned as an open science laboratory.

Increased interest among students towards science and mathematics reflected in their improved academic performances.

Atleast 30% of schools where we worked has received 'A' grade or more in recently concluded Gunotsav conducted by Assam Government. Two of our schools stood first and second in the district.

National Science day celebrated in schools showcasing low cost science experimentation.

Livelihood survey conducted for *One Acre Fund* in Jorhat district.

More than *60 youths* oriented on Solar Energy entrepreneurship in partnership with *SELCO Foundation*.


More than *200 mothers* trained on nutrition and health promoting activities. As well as livelihood promotion through homestead garden, goatery etc.



# Youth Engagement

50 students participated in *Samvidhan live* project in partnership with *CYC Youth Commutiny, Delhi*. 2 students from Jorhat college attended the culmination ceremony at Delhi.

For the first time students got a chance to experience and reflect on constitutional duties and rights.



Organized Youth Debathon in partnership with *Plan India* and *Pravah*. 3 students from our cohort were selected for National edition and out of that 1 was selected for International edition of debathon.

# Systemic Impact

Farmpreneur won the *Social Impact Award* by Sambodhi, Delhi.

Farmpreneur accepted by *Ministry of Human Resource Development*, New Delhi as an experiential learning model.

The annual academic calendar issued by *Assam State Education Department*, one period every month for each class and 30 minutes daily has been allotted for garden work.

More than *60 teachers* trained on Farmpreneur project.
